Adult Discipleship Starting October 20

"How to Be Rich" is a four-week community group study that will encourage conversation and reflection on the biblical themes of financial stewardship and generosity. This video study starts with the premise that, contrary to what you might think, you are already "rich" and probably have more than you need (if you consider wealth distribution globally). Rather than focusing on riches and how to get rich, this study explores what to do with the wealth we already have and how to steward it wisely and live generously. This video study complements and expands the material from Andy Stanley's 2013 book, "How to Be Rich." The book is optional and not required for participants in this study, but it is insightful and helpful.

Those already in a "Circle Up" group can continue with their group for this study. (There is no need to register.)

Those not already in a group are welcome to join a new group for this four-week study. The first 14 to register will receive the book for free!
