Adult Discipleship Starting October 20 - there's still time to register

"How to Be Rich" is a four-week community group study that will encourage conversation and reflection on the biblical themes of financial stewardship and generosity. This video study starts with the premise that, contrary to what you might think, you are already "rich" and probably have more than you need (if you consider wealth distribution globally). Rather than focusing on riches and how to get rich, this study explores what to do with the wealth we already have and how to steward it wisely and live generously. This video study complements and expands the material from Andy Stanley's 2013 book, "How to Be Rich." The book is optional and not required for participants in this study, but it is insightful and helpful.

Those already in a "Circle Up" group can continue with their group for this study. (There is no need to register.) Those not already in a group are welcome to join a new group for this four-week study.

Our Thanksgiving Community Food Ministry Is underway! We're excited to launch our annual Thanksgiving Community Food Ministry! Pearce, together with our sister church Heart & Soul, Rochester Family Mission, other city churches, and local agencies, is identifying families in need throughout the Rochester area. Our shared goal is to provide boxes of food, fresh produce, and frozen turkeys to 1,150 families. Pearce's specific contribution is to prepare 245 Adopt-a-Boxes.

How Can You Help?

- Drop Off Adopt-a-Boxes: Filled Adopt-a-Boxes can be brought to Pearce Church between October 19 and November 17. So far, we've received 65 Adopt-a-Box commitments—let's keep it going!
- Volunteer for Food Collection: Join us on Saturday, November 16 and Sunday, November 17, after our services, to help transport food items, Adopt-a-Boxes, and supplies from various storage areas to the Family Life Center. Volunteers will meet in Pearce's main lobby for instructions.
- Help Pack Thanksgiving Boxes: On Thursday, November 21, we'll gather in the Family Life Center (gym) at 9:30 AM to pack over 800 Thanksgiving boxes. It usually takes 1-2 hours, and we need all hands on deck to ensure families in need have a special meal for the holiday.
