#### Thanksgiving Community Food Ministry:

Our Thanksgiving Community Food Ministry is underway! We're excited to launch this annual ministry. Pearce, together with our sister church Heart & Soul, Rochester Family Mission, other city churches, and local agencies, is identifying families in need throughout the Rochester area. Our shared goal is to provide boxes of food, fresh produce, and frozen turkeys to 1,150 families. Pearce's specific contribution is to prepare 250 Adopt-a-Boxes.

#### How Can You Help?

- Drop Off Adopt-a-Boxes: Filled Adopt-a-Boxes can be brought to Pearce Church between October 19 and November 17. So far, we've received 101 Adopt-a-Box commitments—let's keep it going!
- Volunteer for Food Collection: Join us on Saturday, November 16 and Sunday, November 17, after our services, to help transport food items, Adopt-a-Boxes, and supplies from various storage areas to the Family Life Center. Volunteers will meet in Pearce's main lobby for instructions.
- Help Pack Thanksgiving Boxes: On Thursday, November 21, we'll gather in the Family Life Center (gym) at 9:30 AM to pack over 800 Thanksgiving boxes. It usually takes 1-2 hours, and we need all hands on deck to ensure families in need have a special meal for the holiday.

#### • Backpack Food Program:

Join others on Tuesday, November 12 at 12:00pm at our first monthly Backpack Food Packing event in the Upper Room (Room 251). Together, volunteers will pack enough weekend meals for 42-50 students, filling gallon bags with items like oatmeal, cereal, snacks, canned pasta, and soup. It's a small effort that makes a big difference in the lives of these children.
